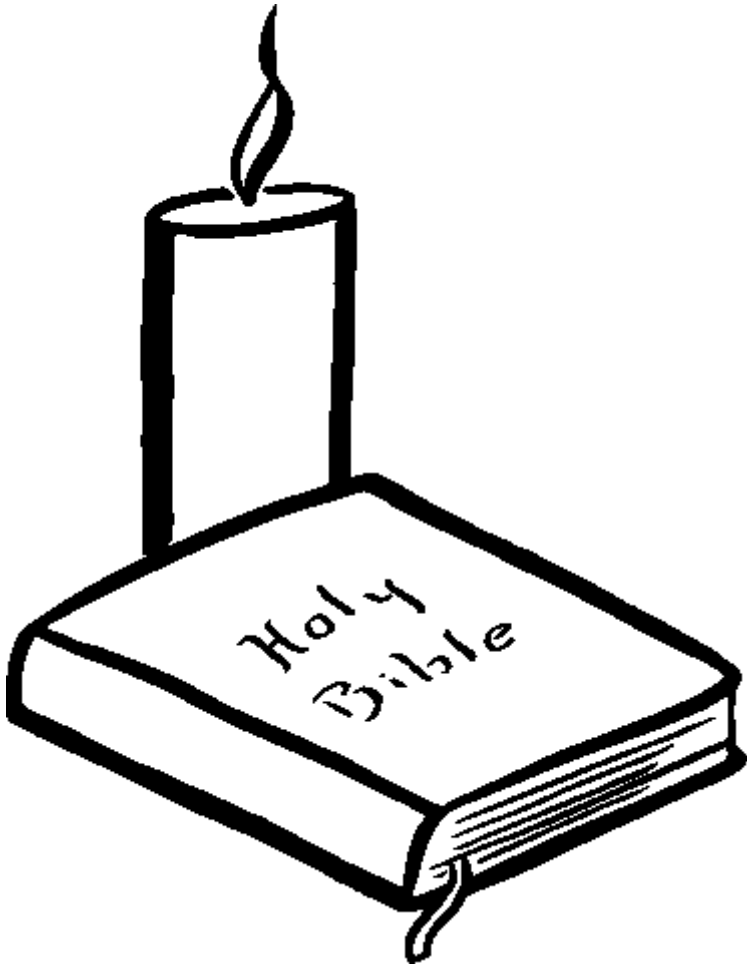

Medical Assistance Fund

The Church in Society committee of OSL has accepted donations and provided a fund-raising event in 2019 in order to fund a Medical Assistance Fund. This program is for members of our church and preschool staff. It provides assistance in paying medical bills directly to the provider. The committee will make four distributions a year until the funds run out. One thousand dollars will be distributed each quarter for the benefit of the approved applicants.

Applications for help can be obtained from the church office. It can be mailed or emailed out as necessary. All information is confidential. Members may be given assistance once in a 12-month period.

The deadline for the applications to be returned to the church office is Nov 25th, 2020 (church office will be closed for Thanksgiving Nov 26 & 27th) for consideration of the fourth quarter assistance.
